Upcoming Demolition Activities

Hartford Petroleum Release Site

Hartford, Illinois

January 2022

Apex Oil Company, Inc. (Apex) will be demolishing twelve residential structures, a garage, and the Hartford Assembly of God Church. These properties are all located north of Hawthorne Avenue, with the majority of the structures in the northeastern portion of the Village of Hartford. First, hazardous materials and recyclable items will be removed from each structure. Second, all structures on the property including garages and sheds will be demolished and the material transported to a local landfill as debris. Following demolition, clean soil will be used to fill any holes and the ground will be properly graded. The final step is for the properties to be reseeded with grass in the early Spring.

Many of these structures are being removed to make space for future remediation equipment. Crews will begin preparation in January and demolition activities will continue throughout the winter months. Demolition activities are expected to be completed in late March 2022, weather permitting. Apex has prepared plans and permit applications and will coordinate the demolition activities with the Illinois EPA, Madison County Soil Conservation District, and the Village of Hartford. Apex appreciates the community's patience and understanding, and we will make every effort to minimize the inconvenience and disruption to the community during the demolition activities.
